

There are No “Moderate” Muslims

There are no “moderate” Muslims, only disobedient ones who refuse to do the will of Allah. The following passages are only a few of the hundreds of scriptures found in the Qur’an promoting violence against unbelievers. We are not doing ourselves, or the “cultural” Muslims who do not align themselves with the teachings of Islam, any favors by not acknowledging the truth that will dominate our lives until either Israel and America (and all their allies) are brought to their knees or the Islamic nations waging a “holy” war against us are brought to their knees.

The historic origin of this holy war goes back to Abraham. The sons of Abraham - Ishmael, the first-born illegitimate son of unbelief, who would become the father of the Islamic nations, and Isaac, the son of faith, and inheritor of God’s covenant blessings, have been at war from the beginning, and America, as a friend of Israel and a nation of “infidels” (unbelievers) is seen as a primary and vehemently hated enemy of Islam.

Qur'an (9:123) - "O you who believe! fight those of the unbelievers who are near to you and let them find in you hardness."

Qur'an (9:30) - "And the Jews say: Ezra is the son of Allah; and the Christians say: The Messiah is the son of Allah; these are the words of their mouths; they imitate the saying of those who disbelieved before; may Allah destroy them;"

Qur'an (8:57) - "If thou comest on them in the war, deal with them so as to strike fear in those who are behind them, that haply they may remember."

Qur'an (8:12) - "I will cast terror into the hearts of those who disbelieve. Therefore strike off their heads and strike off every fingertip of them"

Qur'an (2:191-193) - "And slay them wherever ye find them, and drive them out of the places whence they drove you out, for **persecution [of Muslims] is worse than slaughter [of non-believers]**...and fight them **until persecution is no more, and religion is for Allah.**"

We should not be intolerant of the people from Islamic nations, whether they claim the Muslim faith or not, but we need to be wise. And wisdom would dictate that professing Muslims should not be allowed in our military or our government.

This war is now full “on” whether we like it or not, and peace is not negotiable. Yet, I have no confidence that we, as a nation, will act wisely to pre-empt continuing terrorist acts in America or continuing wars abroad.

We live in dangerous, “wars and rumors of wars” times.
